- Mary was Deputy Principal for three years at the Botswana Wildlife Training Institute where she participated in curriculum preparation and development of training manuals. She headed the Education, Training and Ecotourism Department of the Ministry of Tourism for the Government of Botswana.
- Mary is trained in Environmental Impact assessment (EIA) and in Facilitation skills. During her time in the Ministry of Tourism Botswana, she ran more than 60 seminars on sustainable tourism and tourism awareness.
- As a scholar Mary was a senior wildlife Biologist in the Kalahari for nine years. She has publications in peer-reviewed Journals and wrote an acclaimed book on “Wildlife-friendly fencing in Botswana”.
